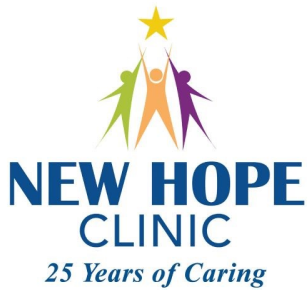

Signing up for Events at the bridge in 2026

Isn't it wonderful that there are always events going on at the bridge?!

We have small groups, day trips, encouraging workshops and many other groups.

Why signing up for events is super important!

1. It helps staff know the group size so they can plan the best meeting space to utilize for everyone's comfort
2. It helps the leader or facilitator know how many to expect and plan if materials are needed to be printed or ordered.
